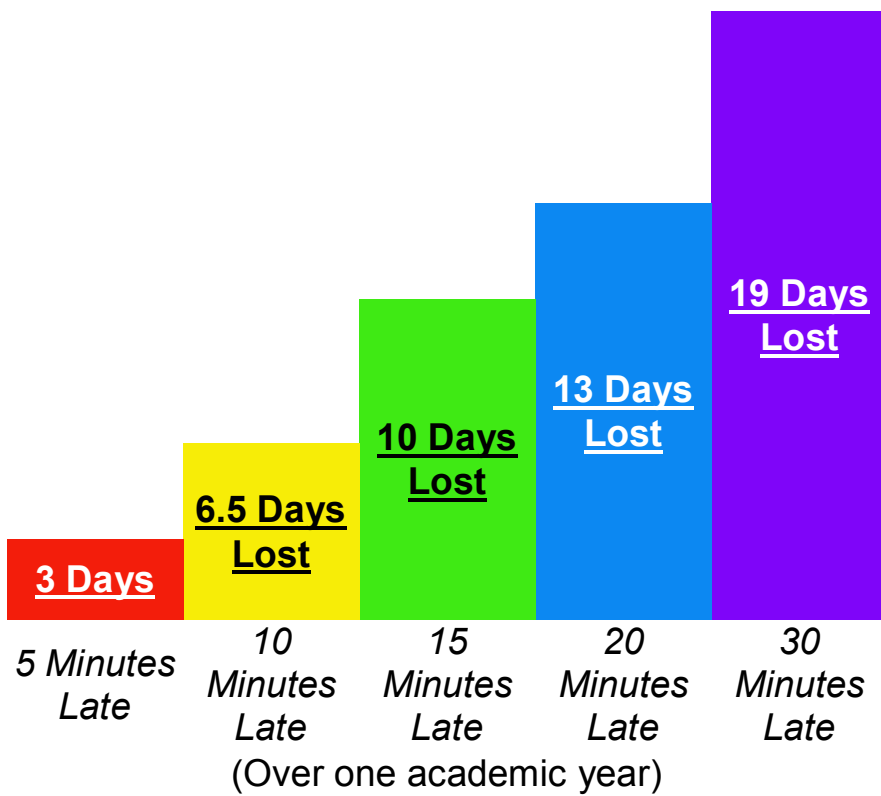
## Sainsburys Active Kids Vouchers

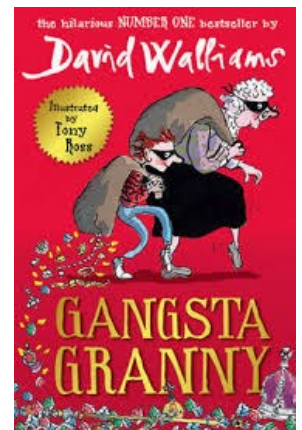


## I Spy ..... Glasses!
