As you may have heard one of our Y5 pupils was hit by a taxi by the school gates this morning. An Ambulance and Police were called and attended quickly and the child was checked by paramedics before being taken to hospital as a precaution. We are happy to report that he is ok and has been released from hospital.

Thank you to all of the parents who helped and offered to be witnesses. Police have taken statements from staff and investigating officers will be contacting those parents who gave their details as witnesses shortly.

We have arranged a meeting with Shabina Afzal, Walsall Councils Sustainable Travel and Road Safety Officer, on Thursday morning to discuss what can be done to make the area safer for our children and families. Our children are precious not only to you but to us as well, and we are doing everything we can to make it as safe as possible. Mr Brownsword has spoken to all of the children this morning about road safety and it would be very useful if you can follow this up at home.

## Summer Fete


Our Summer Fete will be held on 30th June by the PFA. Please look out for more details which will be coming soon.
