Reception - 100% Y3 - 100% Y6 - 100% Y1 - 100% Y4 - 99% Y2 - 99% Y5 - 100%




159 children have had 100% green dojos in the Autumn Term. This is more children than last year and is a fantastic achievement!

Awesome Attendance

From 2nd September - 20th December our attendance was:

Reception - 94.95% Y1 - 94.86% Y2 - 93.18% Y3 - 97.10% Y4 - 93.94% Y5 - 95.09% Y6 - 96.46% Whole School - 95.1%



This is slightly below our target of 96%, however we were hit very hard by the flu bug in December with lots of the children being very poorly. We are confident that this will improve over the Spring Term! 36 children in Reception to Y6 achieved 100% attendance, along with 92 children who had at least 95% attendance - Well Done!
