We are proud to be a Smoke-free School! This means we recognise that pupils, staff and visi-



Momo - Information for Parents

There has recently been a lot of news coverage about Momo, a scary 'challenge' which appears in apps and videos such as Facebook, Youtube, Whatsapp and YouTube Kids. It has been reported that the scary looking doll/puppet figure sends violent images and askes people watching to take part in dangerous challenges, and that children's videos on youtube have been edited by unknown people to include these clips. At the moment there's only hearsay and second-hand accounts, and no reports from official sources that the 'Momo challenge' has led to children harming themselves. Be aware that the image, and surrounding media coverage, might still be frightening to children.

National Online Safety have released some internet safety top tips for parents:

 Tell them it's not real, it is important that children understand that Momo is not a real person and can't physically harm them. Individ-



uals or groups may jump on the bandwagon and create their own versions of the 'Momo challenge' as pranks which is raising the news coverage.

- ★ Be present when your child is online so that you know what they are accessing and which sites/apps they are using. This gives you chance to discuss any concerns they have and for you to stop them viewing certain things.
- It's really important to look out for changes in your child's behaviour as many online challenges encourage secrecy.
- Make sure that you have parental settings in place. Although it may not necessarily stop them viewing Momo it should help to reduce the likelihood. You can also turn off the suggested auto-play on youtube to stop it playing videos that your child has not directly clicked on.
- ★ Talk to your child about peer pressure and how they shouldn't do anything they are not comfortable with, whether this is online or in person.
- Make sure to flag or report any inappropriate material so that it can be removed as soon as possible. You can also block the content to stop your child from viewing it again.
- If your child sees something distressing it is really important that they know where to go to get help and who they can talk to about it. They can always talk to anyone at school about anything they are worried about or call Childline on 0800 1111 where a trained counsellor will listen to anything that is worrying them.
