School Office

The school office is open from **8.30am - 4.15pm**, and we are available by phone and in person between these times. Lates

Children who arrive late (after 8.55am) **MUST** be brought in through the School Office and signed in by an adult. If your child arrives unaccompanied you will receive a telephone call to come and sign them in. This is to ensure that we have an accurate register, as this is used for attendance assemblies, children's awards and Fire Roll call.

- ⊗ *THIS HALF TERM: it has increased to 2 hours 40 minutes learning*
- ⊗ *THIS YEAR: Now they have missed 16 hours or 3 days 1 hour learning*
- ⊗ *BY THE END OF YEAR 2: rising to 9 days and 3 hours learning*
- ⊗ *IN THEIR SCHOOL LIFE: they have missed 38 days and 2 hours or 7 weeks 3 days 2 hours of learning*
