

Geography



At Jubilee Academy, we feel it is significant to nurture and encourage children's natural curiosity, to shape them into inquisitive, questioning learners, who look closely at the world around them and begin to be able to interpret what they see. The children are encouraged to develop a deeper knowledge and understanding of the world around them, alongside key skills which are transferable to other areas of the curriculum. The Geography curriculum is designed in a progressive way which enables children to build on prior knowledge, skills and understanding whilst experiencing engaging learning experiences.

At Jubilee Academy, we use the 'Cornerstones' programme to support the delivery of our teaching and learning.

In Key Stage 1;

Pupils develop knowledge about the world, the United Kingdom and their locality. They are taught basic subject-specific vocabulary relating to human and physical geography and begin to use geographical skills, including first-hand observation, to enhance their locational awareness.

In Key Stage 2;

Pupils extend their knowledge and understanding beyond the local area to include the United Kingdom and Europe, North and South America. This will include the location and characteristics of a range of the world's most significant human and physical features. They develop their use of geographical knowledge, understanding and skills to enhance their locational and place knowledge.
