Safeguarding Focus - Sleep

The National Sleep Helpline have information about this wonderful free resource that can help parents and children to learn more about their sleep and develop better bedtime routines.

Sleep is essential to brain function and by helping children to sleep better, we can help them to succeed in school.

Their free helpline is run by trained sleep advisors, many of whom are specialists in working with SEND. They can talk to young people directly, or parents (they can also talk to adults, including older people, about their sleep issues).
