This Month's Focus - Seasonal staying safe!

5 top tips on how to 5 top tips on how to BRIGHT & BE SEEW 1 Brightly coloured or fluorescent clothing shows up well in daylight and at dusk when you're heading to and from school. 2 If you're out and about when it's dark, wear reflective gear to make sure you can be seen in car headlights. Reflective vests, sashes or wristbands work well. Remember, fluorescent clothing doesn't work after dark! 3 Don't forget to accessorise! Even small items such as clip-on reflectors, armbands and stickers on your outfit or school bag are a great way to improve your visibility. 4 If you like to cycle, remember that it's the law to have clean and working lights at night (white at the front, red at the back).




