



KEY VOCABULARY

composer

a person who writes music

movement

a **self-contained part** of a larger musical composition

symphony

a **long piece of music** usually split into **four movements**

motif

a **short musical idea**

pitch

how **high** or **low** a sound is

tonality

the **character** or **mood** of a piece of music determined by **whether it is based on a major or minor key**

beatboxing

using the **mouth** to make **sounds** (like a **drum machine**)

disco

a style of music with a **strong off-beat** that people like to **dance** to

unison

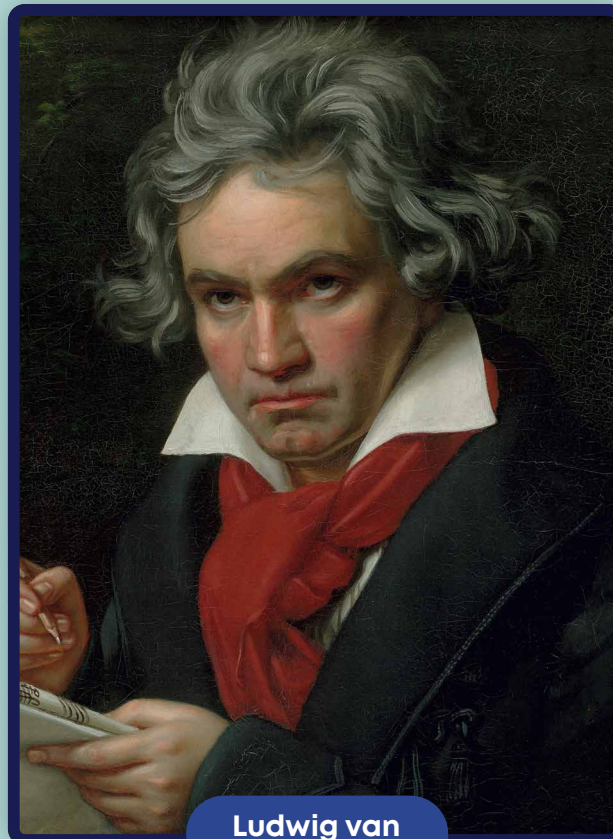
where **two or more instruments** play the **same notes at the same pitch** or **using the same notes**

texture

the sound created by **layering** different parts, one **on top of another**

graphic score

a **picture** which acts as a guide or **musical map** for a piece of music
