



KEY VOCABULARY

The Holy Trinity

the Christian belief that God is **three persons in one** – the **Father**, the **Son** (Jesus), and the **Holy Spirit**

incarnation

the belief that **God became human**, as Jesus, and lived on Earth

Jesus Christ

the central figure in Christianity, believed by Christians to be the **Son of God** who came to teach, help others, and bring people closer to God

temptation

in Christianity, temptation means **wanting to do something that goes against what God teaches** – even if it seems fun, easy, or popular

sin

many Christians believe a sin is a **wrong that goes against what God teaches**

forgiveness

letting go of anger or hurt when someone has done something wrong and choosing not to stay upset with them

parable

a simple **story** that Jesus told to **teach people important lessons** about life and faith

generosity

being **kind** and **giving to others**, sharing time, help, or things without expecting anything back

humble

not showing off or acting like you're better than others – it's about being **respectful, modest**, and treating everyone as **equal**

humility

the quality of putting others first – **being humble**

many Christians believe Jesus had human emotions and qualities like these



righteous anger

Jesus cleansing the temple
many Christians believe one can get angry in a way that does not dishonour God or cause you to sin



forgiveness

'Forgive them Father, they know not what they do'
many Christians believe Jesus forgave those who put him on the cross



generosity

Jesus and Zacchaeus
Jesus went into Zacchaeus' home and was kind to him despite Zacchaeus being very unpopular



humility

The Last Supper
many Christians believe Jesus washed his disciples' feet to show he was humble and served them
